Re: The Luke Commission Compassionate Medicine



RE: R.F.M. LABORATORY COMMENTS ON THE LUKE COMMISSION.

THE R.F.M. LABORATORY IS VERY GREATFUL THAT THE COMMISSION CAME AT THE RIGHT TIME WHEN SWAZILAND IS DESPERATELY IN NEED OF HOME VISITS FOR ITS PATIENTS FROM HEALTH WORKERS LIKE DOCTORS, NURSES AND PARAMEDICS. THE PRESENCE OF THE LUKES COMMISSION IS A BLESSING TO THE ENTIRE NATION AND WE HOPE A LARGE FUND OF SUCH CAN BE ESTABLISHED FOR OUR COUNTRY SO AS TO BE AN ONGOING PROCESS FOR GOOD.

R.F.M. LABORATORY IS A REGIONAL REFERRAL LABORATORY PERFORMING APPROXIMATELY 500,000 TESTS A YEAR. THE TESTING INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING DISCIPLINES: CLINICAL CHEMISTRY, HAEMATOLOGY, SEROLOGY, URINALYSIS AND PARASITOLOGY, CD4 CELL COUNTING, MICROBIOLOGY AND T.B. MICROSCOPY FOR Z.N STAIN. THE LABORATORY CATERS FOR ALL PRIVATE DOCTORS AROUND THE REGION INCLUDING THE LUBOMBO REGION AND THE LUKE COMMISSION HAS NOW BEEN INCLUDED.

THE LUKE COMMISSION HAVE BROUGHT SOME SAMPLES FOR CD4 CELL TESTING, CBC (COMPLETE BLOOD COUNTING), CHEMISTRY SAMPLES FOR THE KIDNEY, HEART AND LIVER FUNCTION TESTS MAINLY AS BASE LINE TESTS FOR THEIR HIV POSITIVE PATIENTS AND SICK PATIENTS.

TO MY VIEW THERE IS A NEED TO EXPAND THE COMMISSION AND HAVE MORE DOCTORS, MOBILE CLINICS AND PERSONEL TO COVER ALL PATIENTS. WITH THE PRESENCE OF THE STAFF THE WORK IS A HEAVY LOAD ON THEM BUT GOD ALMIGHTY HAS HELPED THEM TO GO THROUGH ALL THE CLINICS.

MAY GOD CONTINUOUSLY TOUCH AND BLESS YOU. WE WISH TO SUPPORT YOU MUCH BETTER AS YOU SERVE THE LORD AND WE WILL ALWAYS REMEMBER YOU IN OUR PRAYERS
