



How The Luke Commission Serves Swaziland

- Target rural communities with limited or no access to healthcare
- Partner with community leaders to pinpoint health needs and to coordinate health services at each mobile hospital outreach site
- Train and empower local Swazi staff to provide program and health services
- Offer free compassionate, comprehensive medical services including diagnoses and treatment, medications with written instructions in SiSwati, HIV testing and counseling, TB screening and testing, vision care and eyeglasses, cataract surgeries and children's eye examinations, wheelchair and assistive devices for disabled persons, neonatal and voluntary adult male circumcision surgeries, minor surgical procedures, health education, domestic violence and substance abuse assistance, family planning and Jadelle procedures
- Provide point-of-care laboratory, digital x-ray, and pharmacy services
- Engage Swazi pastors, school headmasters, and TinkhundLa representatives to participate in their community's healthcare
- Provide follow-up care for HIV+, ART initiation, TB, other chronic and surgical patients



Vision: To end the isolation of rural communities to quality, compassionate healthcare.

Mission: To deliver compassionate, comprehensive healthcare to the most isolated and underserved populations of southern Africa in collaboration with local communities, government, corporate, and non-profit partners.

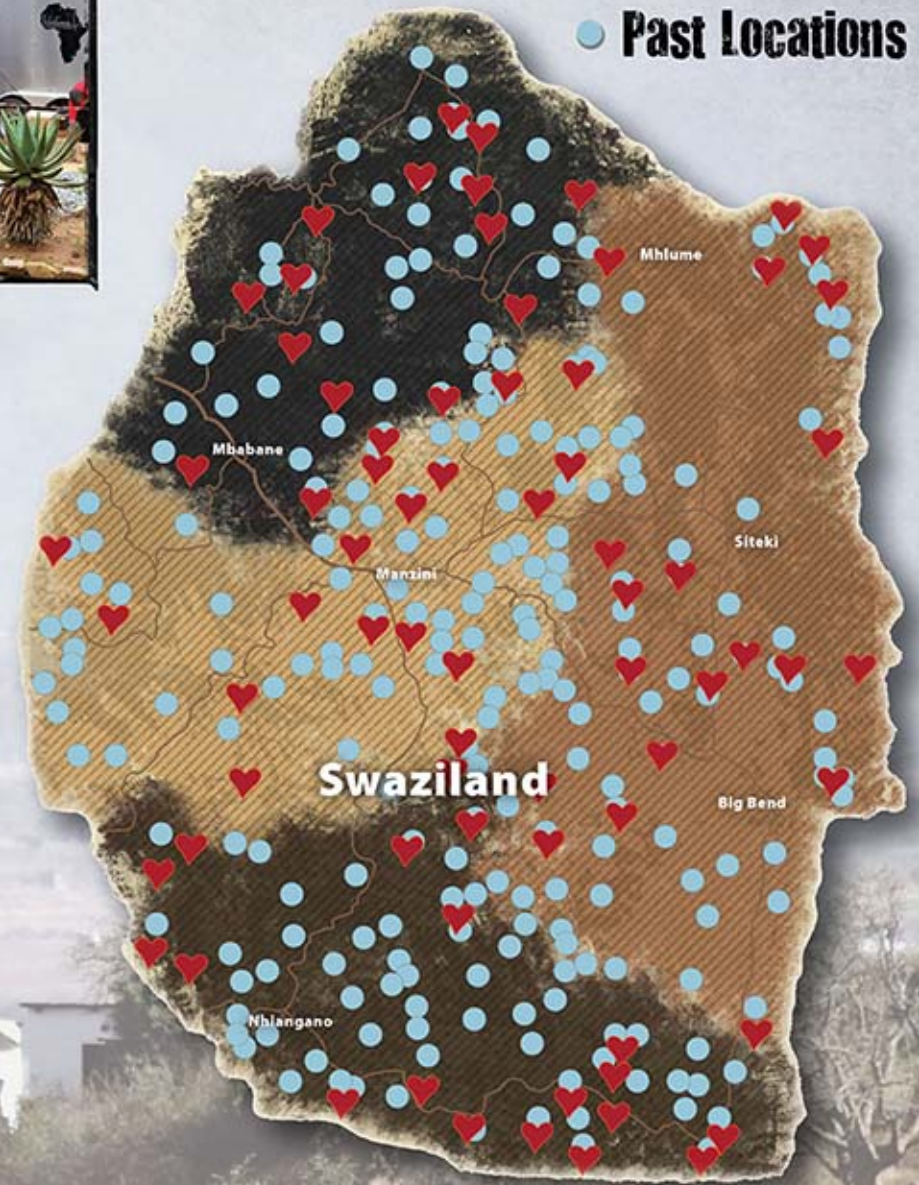
